



1. A report with recommendations for a marine park in the Port Phillip Heads area will be presented separately to the Minister (see Part 1, section 1, page 7 of the Draft Report).

2. In the ECC's Interim Report (1998), two marine aquaculture areas - Pinnacle Channel (marine) and Avalon (land-based) - were recommended. The Government is currently considering these recommendations.
