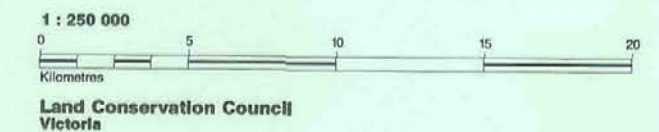

Notes:

- The reference numbers of the various reserves shown on these maps refer to the same areas indicated in the L.C.C. Final Recommendations for the Mallee area of May 1977, although subsequent boundary changes have been incorporated. G34, G35, F7, L39 and P6, however, indicate reserves set aside after the Council's recommendations. Several new bushland reserves have also been gazetted and these are included within the numbering system of that category.
- Most of the areas recommended for alienation in the 1977 recommendations have now been taken up under Improvement Purchase Leases and are no longer considered to be public land.
- Public land water frontage reserves cannot be accurately defined at this map scale nor are all reserves indicated. Refer to the appropriate Parish plan to determine the boundaries of the reserve and whether it is on one, or both, sides of the stream.
- Some reserves cannot be accurately defined at this map scale; these reserves are indicated by a coloured dot e.g. O56.
- 'Lake Reserve' at Lake Hindmarsh conforms with the Council's 1986 Final Recommendations for the Wimmera area.
